This was stated by the Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, <u>Hafiz Aakif Saeed</u>, during the Khitab-e-Jumu'ah at Quran Academy, Lahore.

The Ameer, while commenting on the on-going visit of Israeli PM Benjamin Netanyahu to India noted that the unprecedented six-day long visit of the Zionist PM to Hindu-extremist India, along with a hefty delegation containing over 200 entrepreneurs of Israeli firms, suggested that after knocking out its Arab opposition in the Middle East, the Zionist state had its eyes fixed on hurting nuclear Pakistan and said that both India and Israel wanted to take practical steps in this regard.

While commenting on the rant against the parliament made by certain political leaders, the Ameer remarked that while a couple of political leaders of Pakistan had used irresponsible and controversial words against the institution, which was neither warranted nor wise, yet the role of parliament too had to be scrutinized under a microscope to determine whether its performance in the past had been worthy of any praise. The institution of parliament was the one that had recently made the long-standing and agreed-upon position of Muslims on the issue of *Khatm-e-Nabuwat* controversial by legislating recklessly, he said. The Ameer noted that the parliament had previously tried to pave the way for profanity and vulgarity in the country by passing the *Huquq-e-Niswan* Bill (the so-called Women's' Rights Bill). He added that the same parliament had tried to legislate for the removal of Islamic content from the educational curriculum of Pakistan. He lamented that the parliament had not made any progress whatsoever towards the establishment of the Islamic System in Pakistan during our 71-year history. The Ameer concluded by stating that be it an individual or an institution, it is only the attitude, actions and performance that make one venerated or undignified in the eyes of others.
