## EDITORIAL

All praise is due to Allah (SWT), and peace & blessing on his noble Messengers (AS), in particular, on the last of them all the blessed Prophet Muhammad (SAAW).

The only possible response to the hasty offer Israeli Foreign Minister Yair Lapid made to the Palestinians to conduct "a joint pathological investigation" into the killing of renowned Al Jazeera journalist Shireen Abu Akleh can be rage. Such "investigations" conducted by illegitimate Zionist Israel serve not to uncover the truth but to bury it, not to establish accountability but to preserve impunity, not to indict the perpetrators but to protect them. The Zionist state compounded its criminality by then attacking the funeral procession of Shireen Abu Akleh. Only the Zionist monsters can do that and still get away it.

That the offer for a "joint investigation" into the killing of Abu Akleh came directly from Foreign Minister Lapid – and was later repeated by Prime Minister Naftali Bennett – speaks to the magnitude of Israel's concern about the public relations crisis it is now facing. Such offers for "investigation" and "analysis" are normally left to lower-ranking officials in Israel's whitewash apparatus. Indeed, Israel only engages in such high-level whitewash if it believes the killing of a Palestinian can damage the country's image. Otherwise, it doesn't even bother with such empty gestures.

Israel's investigation mechanism is clearly a charade. Even if an investigation into the killing of a Palestinian at the hands of Israeli forces is opened, it almost never concludes with someone being charged. The entire mechanism is a charade because its flaws are, in fact, its essential features – the ones that enable it to deliver impunity.

To begin with, the army is tasked with investigating itself. Soldiers are typically interviewed without being challenged, almost no effort is made to collect external evidence, and "investigations" are drawn out for years. On top of all this, even the sham described above is directed only at low-ranking soldiers – those who make the policies that enable soldiers to pull the trigger on Palestinians never face any scrutiny. All this, despite in many cases fatalities being caused not because of any deviations from the policies of the Israeli military but the criminal policies themselves.

Take, for example, the cases of Israeli snipers shooting at unarmed Palestinians at the Gaza fence during the Great March of Return demonstrations. Israel conducted "investigations" into certain specific cases of shooting by snipers. But no one investigated – and no one in Israel will – the rules of engagement themselves. Israel's military advocate general – the very same person in charge of Israel's military investigations – is tasked with giving the green light for such policies. Thus, obviously, nobody is being held to account for giving snipers those flagrantly illegal orders.

Israel needs impunity to maintain its apartheid regime. It cannot maintain control over a subjugated population without state violence. Thus, it is essential for the regime to provide itself with blanket impunity – while performing what looks like investigations, to appease international expectations. Impunity paves the way for more killings.

Israel will not hold itself to account, just like its apartheid regime won't dismantle itself. International stakeholders who do not call this out simply cast themselves as a cog in Israel's whitewashing machine. The grotesque US pressure on Palestinians to accept a "joint" investigation and the statement by US Ambassador to Israel Tom Nides vaguely "encouraging" an investigation, only demonstrates the extent to which the Biden administration continues to serve as such a cog.

The prime minister of the illegitimate Zionist state of Israel Naftali Bennet, born to American parents who immigrated from San Francisco to Israel in 1967, is a far-right ultranationalist who staunchly opposes Palestinian statehood or self-determination of any kind in Palestine/Israel. From 2010 to 2012 Bennet was head of the main political body (Yesha Council) that represents Israeli settlers living on occupied Palestinian land in violation of international law and is a staunch supporter of Israel's settlement enterprise.

A former member of the Likud party, he was Netanyahu's chief of staff from 2006-2008. As the leader of the Jewish Home party (2012-2018), he was a key partner in Netanyahu's coalition government, serving as minister of education and minister of diaspora affairs. During the previous government, he was minister of economy and minister of religious services. He was also minister of education (2015-2019) and minister of defense (2019-2020) under Netanyahu. In 2018, he left Jewish Home to form the New Right party. On 13 June 2021 he became the prime minister of the illegitimate Zionist state.

Bennett has repeatedly stated his categorical opposition to a Palestinian state being created in the occupied territories. Instead, he proposes Israel unilaterally annex the approximately 60% of the Palestinian West Bank that fell under full Israeli control under the supposedly temporary Oslo Accords, where most Israeli settlements are located. In 2014, Bennett told journalists Israel "will be gradually attempting to apply Israeli law [annexing] on Israeli controlled areas of Judea and Samaria [the occupied West Bank]." In 2013, he declared: "I favor implementation of Israeli sovereignty over the zone where 400,000 (settlers) live and only 70,000 Arabs." Bennett also ridiculed then-ongoing US-led negotiations under the Obama administration, declaring it's "all a joke."

In 2014, Bennett wrote an op-ed for The New York Times, "For Israel, Two-State Is No Solution," repeating once again his opposition to Palestinian self-determination and his plan to annex 60% of the West Bank. In 2013, he told the New Yorker magazine: "I will do everything in my power, forever, to fight against a Palestinian state being founded in the Land of Israel." A few months later, in June, he declared: "The most important thing in the Land of Israel is to build, build, build [settlements]. It's important that there will be an Israeli presence everywhere. Our principal problem is still Israel's leaders' unwillingness to say in a simple manner that the Land of Israel belongs to the People of Israel."

In 2014, then-Minister of the Economy and Religious Services Bennett released a letter addressed to Palestinian citizens of Israel, who make up about 20% of the population, warning them against becoming a "fifth column."

Bennett also advocates increased Jewish control over the revered Al-Aqsa Mosque Complex in occupied East Jerusalem, which is the third holiest site in Islam. Extremist messianic Jews want to build a temple in the Noble Sanctuary, which would spark a major religious conflagration in the region and beyond. In February 2014, Bennett told a meeting of the Conference of Presidents of Major Jewish Organizations that Israel was attempting to exercise greater control over the Noble Sanctuary, stating that he had already taken measures that would "ultimately influence the eastern side of Jerusalem, and that will include the Temple Mount."

In October 2018, Bennett said that if he were defense minister, he would order a shoot to kill policy against Palestinians attempting to walk across the boundary between Israel and Gaza, where nearly 2 million people have been trapped under an illegal Israeli siege and naval blockade for 15 years. When asked if he would instruct soldiers to kill Palestinian children, Bennett said, "They are not children — they are terrorists. We are fooling ourselves. I see the photos." At that point, at least 140 demonstrators had been killed by Israeli soldiers, including at least 29 children according to the UN, as well as medical workers and journalists, and more than 29,000 others injured, as part of the Great March of Return.

With Israeli wolves breathing down their necks, Palestinians are largely on their own, resistance their only option, staying the course no matter the long odds against them. The history of Occupied Palestine is the triumph of wrong over right, a festering injustice, an entire people harmed, no end to their suffering in sight, no interest in their rights and welfare by the world community.

Unfortunately, the "Muslim Ummah" and its leaderships are criminally silent on Israeli atrocities. Utterly indifferent and completely powerless to the plight of the Palestinians, they are "satisfied" that their own nation states are not in any imminent danger, at least for now. It is, truly, a shame!

**Lahore (PR): “Call for elections can dispel the atmosphere of tension and conflict in the country.”**

This was said by the Ameer of Tanzeem-e-Islami, **Shujauddin Shaikh**, in a statement.
