All praise is due to Allah (SWT), and peace & blessing on his noble Messengers (AS), in particular, on the last of them all the blessed Prophet Muhammad (SAAW).

Pariah regimes are known to decay until they turn lifeless. South Africa under white minority rule is a perfect example. Israel faces a similar ignominious end. It is a replica of the South African National Party's apartheid ideology, coupled with racist Zionism and underpinned by settler colonialism, Israel has reached the end of an inglorious reign.

Just as South Africa in its final throes committed horrendous atrocities in the foolish belief that slaughter of anti-apartheid opponents would allow it to sustain its oppressive rule, Israel today is caught in the same rut. Israel believes that possessing nukes along with a powerful army replenished with sophisticated weapons, having the back of the United States and buoyed by the world media, makes it invincible.

The "go to hell" approach whereby it conducts daily rituals of cold-blooded assassinations has all the hallmarks of a rotten regime. Brute military force to punish Palestinians for daring to demand fundamental human rights, epitomizes medieval tyranny. As successive Israeli war criminals keep repeating blunders in pursuit of misplaced Jewish supremacy, they clearly are blinded by hate and prejudice against the indigenous Palestinian population of Muslims and Christians.

Unlike rational understanding and acceptance of the inevitability of mistakes coming back to haunt them, Israel persists doggedly to discriminate, oppress and punish Palestinians with impunity.

Menachem Begin, the arch-terrorist responsible for genocidal acts resulting in ethnic cleansing of the Palestinians, suggested during a speech as Prime Minister to the Knesset during the PLO's expulsion in 1982, that Israel was on the verge of enjoying 40 years of peace. Begin cited the Biblical passage "and the land was quiet for forty years," saying it might well apply to Israel now that "the northern border threat had been dealt with."

Israeli leaders have followed a false paradigm since 1948: the narrative that applying military force will keep the colonial entity "safe and peaceful". Little did Israel know that the 1982 invasion of Lebanon would not only fail to pave way for its unchallenged rule but also lead to the emergence of Hezbollah and sow the seeds of the first Intifada in 1987, resulting in the rise of Hamas and Islamic Jihad.

As far as the 'community of world nations' is concerned, Israel has a unique, yet sinister relationship to the UN. UN General Assembly resolution 181 of 1947 proposed carving a new Jewish state out of historic Palestine. It was passed by 33-13, with 10 abstentions. Israel quickly embraced UN resolution 181. Its own Declaration of Independence cites UN 181 as recognition of its right to exist. While 'awarding' 55% historic Palestine to the new illegal Jewish State, resolution 181 also included provisions for the protection of minorities inside each of the two new states. These included: "No discrimination of any kind shall be made between the inhabitants on the ground of race, religion, language or sex." "All persons within the jurisdiction of the State shall be entitled to equal protection of the laws." "No expropriation of land owned by an Arab in the Jewish State (or by a Jew in the Arab State) shall be allowed except for public purposes." But it rapidly became clear to the international community that Zionist forces had no intention of respecting many of UN's provisions.

In fact, by its Creation Day on May 14, 1948, Zionist militias had already seized more land than had been allotted under the UN plan and had driven out over 350,000 Palestinians. The UN General Assembly responded by voting through another resolution (194) in December 1948 affirming that those refugees have the right to return and to compensation. (The vote was 35-15 with 8 abstentions.)

When Israel sought membership in the UN a few months later, it promised to respect all relevant UN resolutions. The UN was divided on whether Israel should in fact be admitted, but US and European domination of the UN awarded Israel UN membership. But while Israel adopted the part of the UN proposal giving it a Jewish state, Israel defied the UN proposal in that it:

- Seized much more land than proposed in the partition plan (78% vs. 55% of historic Palestine)
- Took over Jaffa and seized West Jerusalem
- Expelled over 750,000 Palestinians
- Confiscated their property
- Destroyed over 400 villages
- Prevented refugees from returning
- Restricted the civil rights of the Palestinians who remained in Israel

As former General Secretary Kofi Annan said in remarks after leaving the UN in 2006, Israel's defiance of UN provisions is a painful and festering sore for the UN. "The failure to achieve an Arab-Israeli peace remains for the UN a deep internal wound as old as the organization itself, (...) a painful and festering sore consequently felt in almost every intergovernmental organ and Secretariat body." "No other issue carries such a powerful symbolic and emotional charge affecting people far from the zone of conflict." (Kofi Annan, *Interventions* (2011), p. 254)

The repeated UNGA votes condemning Israel and supporting the Palestinians are not just based on the fact that Israel is the worst abuser of human rights in the world. Nor is it because the whole world is antisemitic. Many of the countries which vote to support Palestinian rights have never had any significant Jewish communities. The fundamental reason is that Israel, a UN member, albeit an illegitimate state, continues to ignore the commitments it made to the UN when it was admitted in 1949 and repeated UN warnings about the occupation of 1967.

But there is also a significant element of political posturing. The annual spate of UN resolutions on "The Question of Palestine" gives the global south a forum for brandishing their opposition to the effects of European colonialism. Even some rather reactionary regimes, like Saudi Arabia and the other Abrahamic Accord states, voted to support the Palestinians in the UNGA resolutions. Politics is often a mixture of principle and posturing. But if Israel continues to ignore UN resolutions, it can expect mounting frustration in the Muslims Ummah, the international community and a continuation of world criticism every year at the UNGA.

Whether Israel assassinates journalists such as Shireen Abu Akleh; imprisons and tortures leaders of the Resistance; demolishes homes and destroys farmlands; raids, plunders and bombs Gaza; it cannot subdue Palestine's spirited struggle to free itself from the yoke of Zionist brutality. The message is loud and clear: The Palestinian people will neither retreat nor surrender.

Western regimes and media are complicit in Israeli crimes and must be held accountable. The bottom line is that it all fits into The Yinon Plan, The Zionist Plan for the Middle East, a plan to expand Israel's territorial claims and dominate the region as a Jewish state (Greater Israel). Israelis have openly professed in the UN that "the Promised Land extends from the River of Egypt up to the Euphrates; it includes parts of Syria and Lebanon." Israel carries out false-flag operations to blame Muslim countries, and in that guise keeps oppressing Palestinians and waging wars with its neighbors. Muslims states must take practical measures to counter the illegitimate Zionist entity.

## 21 years since the false flag – 9/11

Time flies. It has been 21 years since three World Trade Center skyscrapers designed to withstand airliner collision were destroyed. Building 7 was brought down by controlled demolition as its collapse at free fall acceleration proves conclusively. The destruction of the twin towers was accompanied by a series of explosions, and these buildings also fell into their own footprints at essentially free fall acceleration. The US government's official coverup story has been totally demolished by authors such as David Ray Griffin, by scholarly conferences, university investigations, expert reports, and by Architects and Engineers for 9/11 truth. The great mass of evidence that has been accumulated proves that the official narrative is false, but it doesn't say who was responsible for the attack. Some, such as Ron Unz, Laurent Guyenot, and Chris Bollyn, have noted the Israeli Connection, but the focus has been on the total implausibility of the official narrative, not on the who and why of the attack.

Circumstantial evidence suggests that 9/11 was a scheme of George W. Bush regime neoconservative officials allied with vice president Dick Cheney and Israel led by Ariel Sharon to create a “new Pearl Harbor” that would generate support on the part of the American people and Washington’s European allies for a “war on terror in the Middle East and South Asia, whose real purpose was to destroy Israel’s enemies in the interest of Greater Israel.

Commentary Magazine editor Norman Podhoretz had called for such a war, Editor Gerald Flurry of the Evangelist magazine Philadelphia Trumpet announced of its imminence and General Wesley Clark reported that he was informed of Pentagon war plans to that effect.

This is the most plausible explanation, and most likely the truth, yet it is not one that the US and Israeli governments would ever acknowledge. During the last 20 years, we’ve written at length about 9/11 and reviewed the careful work of those proving the counterfactual and implausible nature of the official account given by the Western governments and the mainstream media.

Twenty-one years after the launch of the global War on Terror, many historians and commentators have proficiently reflected on the futility of America’s destructive wars in Afghanistan, Iraq, Libya and elsewhere. Fueled by neocons and right-wing extremists, the unforgivable hate-speech characterizing an Islamophobic narrative became synonymous with the War on Terror. Language of hate to demonize victims of the American empire became shorthand script for architects of the War on Terror. And shamelessly embraced by self-proclaimed “analysts/experts” as well as by embedded journalists, resulting in racial and religious profiling.

It has been a little over one year since the American troops were airlifted from the “graveyard of empires”. The US has been trying to sabotage the Afghan Taliban government during that time. The Afghan Taliban regime has been able to withstand the Western onslaught of economic sanctions, media campaign against their Islamic values and lack of support from any country. We pray for their success.

However, we would take this opportunity to revisit devastating effects of the US invasions and occupations during the last 21 years, since 9/11. The architects garnered public support by demonizing Islam and constructed a framework of laws and policies that perpetrated injustice on an unprecedented scale against Muslim populations. Disproportionate power wielded by the US and riding on the angry emotions generated by 9/11, it embarked on executing plots to force the world to side with it. Overnight America rammed through the UN Security Council a series of resolutions to legitimize its aggressive and unjust wars.

One such resolution obligated member states to implement counterterrorism legislation setting the scene for a global War on Terror. The results were devastating. The infrastructure of hate was then used to suppress dissenting voices and erode civil liberties for all. The surveillance state, securitization and erosion of the rule of law that we see today are manifestations of that toxic campaign. Globally, failed wars have seen the devastation of entire nations through direct invasions and proxy wars, causing the deaths of more than 2 million and the displacement of 37 million people, according to the most conservative estimates.

Coincidentally, it was in August 1996 that the Afghan Taliban first swept into Kabul to take-over from the warlords that had caused havoc once the Soviet army departed. And on August 15, 2021, the resistance movement entered the presidential palace to confirm their peaceful and rightful takeover of Kabul as the US-installed puppet president Ashraf Ghani fled the country. The Taliban also delivered a parting kick to India on its Independence Day. All Indian ‘diplomats’ including the ambassador fled Afghanistan. Most of them were agents of India’s intelligence agency, RAW, operating under diplomatic cover.

It was the culmination of not only a 10-day lightning campaign but also a 20-year struggle that pitted the lightly armed Taliban fighters against the heavily-armed US military machine. Add to that thousands of allied troops and one can see the rout the Western crusaders suffered at the hands of people charged with the spirit of Imaan (faith-commitment). Indeed, it was a stunning victory of Imaan over weapons, arrogance and hubris.

Contrary to the doom and gloom predictions of a civil war, the Taliban demonstrated remarkable sophistication and magnanimity. There were no revenge killings in Kabul or elsewhere during the first year of the Afghan Taliban regime. Despite being a financial nightmare and the US robbing \$7-9 billion worth of Afghanistan’s reserves, the Afghan Taliban regime has been able to keep the dollar from spiraling out of control and the economy has not tanked. On the contrary, the Afghan Taliban regime has, or is in the process of, striking energy, mining and infrastructure deals with China, Russia and Iran. The real spoilers in Afghanistan, during the last one year or so, have been the US itself, its client states and the US-backed and sponsored terrorist organization Daesh.

It would thus be wrong to assume that Western mischief-making is over, not least that of the US where a heated debate has been taking place for almost a year over the manner of the US withdrawal from Afghanistan. The Washington warlords who accused President Joe Biden of “abandoning” Afghanistan in August 2021, have their eyes set on the region again. They want to destabilize Afghanistan. They want conflict in Taiwan. They are looking to debilitate Russia.

Afghanistan was a war of lies, sustained by the powerful US and British lobbyists and media. The tide, however, changed in August 2021. The Afghan Taliban restored the Islamic Emirates of Afghanistan.

It is shameful that no country has recognized the government of the Afghan Taliban even after one year. Muslim countries and other powers of the global south that claim to be the supporters of Afghanistan have still not recognized the legal government of the Afghan Taliban. All Muslim countries, including Pakistan, must immediately recognize the Islamic Emirates of Afghanistan and provide all form of assistance and support to the Afghan Taliban, in order to help them establish a stable and robust government in Afghanistan.

**Date: 26 August 2022**

**Lahore (PR): Floods have wreaked havoc in Pakistan but the government and opposition are shamelessly busy in power politics.**

This was said by the Ameer of Tanzeem-e-Islami, **Shujauddin Shaikh**, in a statement. The Ameer said that the crippling monsoon rains, starting in July 2022, and the ensuing floods have severely lashed Karachi, Hyderabad, Interior Sindh, Balochistan and South Punjab, with almost half of Pakistan marooned and thousands of villages inundated. According to official reports, more than one thousand people have been killed, hundreds of thousands left homeless, with their properties and livestock swept away, and crops have been destroyed on a large scale. The floods have caused absolute mayhem and devastation, yet it is utterly disgraceful that the government and opposition appear to be least interested in helping those afflicted by the floods and are instead engaged in power politics and the effort to overthrow one another. The PM of Pakistan, CMs of all provinces and top leaders of the ruling coalition in the Centre are only giving lip service and have failed in providing either protection before floods or adequate relief to those afflicted by the floods. The Ameer said that the chairman of PTI, Imran Khan, who claims to be the most popular political leader of the country has neither visited the flood affected areas nor has he directed his party regarding rescue and relief efforts for those affected. He should postpone all political activities for a few weeks and focus only on rescue and relief operations. PTI is in power in Punjab and KP, yet its provincial governments have shown the same irresponsible and callous attitude as the provincial governments of Sindh and Balochistan. The Ameer said that at a time when floods have wreaked havoc in the country, the foreign visit of the PM was uncalled for. He should have stayed in Pakistan, standing by those affected by the floods. The Ameer demanded that the federal and provincial governments must focus on organizing a robust rescue, relief and rehabilitation operation, with mutual coordination. It is also the duty of all political parties and welfare organizations to provide full assistance to those affected by floods, in this time of need. The religious organizations must also fully participate in relief and rescue efforts. The Ameer directed the Ruffaqa of Tanzeem-e-Islami to fully participate in helping their Pakistani brethren in this hour of need, according to the official policy of Tanzeem-e-Islami. He said that indeed trials and warnings of this nature are often a consequence of our transgressions. We ought to sincerely repent and seek the forgiveness of Allah (SWT) for our sins. In the end, the Ameer supplicated that may Allah (SWT) have mercy on those affected by the floods and make this trial become a cause for the masses to mend their ways and revert to Allah (SWT).

**Lahore (PR): The dance and music festivities arranged by the government on the Independence Day of Pakistan is extremely shameful.**

This was said by the Ameer of Tanzeem-e-Islami, **Shujauddin Shaikh**, during the Khitab e Jumu'ah in Quran Academy Lahore. The Ameer lamented that it is a matter of great shame that the PDM coalition government, which includes ideological and religious political parties, flouted the ideology of Pakistan and our religious edicts by arranging festivities of dance and music, and made a mockery of our cherished values of modesty and decency.
