Lahore (PR): "The Fall of Dhaka, in fact, befell due to our failure to practically implement the Ideology of Pakistan."

This was said by the Ameer of Tanzeem-e-Islami, Shujauddin Shaikh, in a statement. He noted that remembering and observing 16 December as a "Black Day' or blaming each other for the break-up of Pakistan into two parts, would not help in any way in resolving the problems being faced by the 'present' Pakistan. Had the Ideology of Pakistan been practically implemented immediately after independence in 1947, i.e., the Islamic System of Collective Justice been established, then Pakistan would not have been broken-up into two part, but instead it would have sprouted and matured as an extremely strong and stable country of the region, and despite the geographical distance between them, both parts of the country would have been a source of stability and harmonizing strength for each other. He remarked that our conundrum is that we have not learnt any lesson from that prodigious disaster and, even today, certain so-called leaders are trying to create social-class-based and linguistic discord in the country. He said that we have tried the structures of parliamentary democracy, the presidential system and martial law, yet the circumstances of Pakistan are not improving, rather increasingly deteriorating on a consistent basis. He observed that, therefore, we ought to reflect and decide, on the basis of both faith and reason, regarding which system would make Pakistan a great nation. He asserted that whichever metric we use, we inevitably reach the same conclusion, without fail, that in order to ensure the survival and security of Pakistan, it is imperative for us to establish the genuine and complete Islamic system in our country. The Ameer concluded by affirming that we are such a fortunate nation that our success in this world and in the Hereafter is knotted to a single factor - Islam!
